## Register Now

1. Create an electronic copy of your
  - valid Passport; or
  - valid Permanent Resident Card

No other forms of identification are accepted.

You will be required to upload an electronic copy of your ID during the registration process.

2. Go to [www.ieltscanada.ca/TestDates](http://www.ieltscanada.ca/TestDates) to select your test date and location.

Complete the online registration and pay the fee. You will receive a confirmation of your registration by email, with a link to 30 days of free online preparation.

## On Test Day

### Bring:

- Valid original identification.  
Note: must be the original and valid (not a photocopy) of your Passport or Permanent Resident Card used to register.
- A copy of email confirmation (paper or electronic)
- Two HB or #2 pencils
- Erasers
- Pencil sharpener with a canister
- Clear bottle of water with the label removed (if desired)

All other items will be locked in the cloak room during the test. Please do not bring valuables on test day.

### Test Day Schedule

---

8:15 – 9:15 a.m. Test day registration

---

9:30 a.m. Listening section commences and is followed by Reading and Writing. These three sections last for three hours in the morning with no break.

---

12:30 p.m. Lunch break

---

1:20 p.m. Speaking section. 11–14 minutes per candidate.  
Note: speaking times are randomly assigned and cannot be changed.  
The interview time will be provided in the morning during the registration time.

---

6:00 p.m. All speaking interviews are usually completed by 6 pm.\*
